Potion Maah was celebrated by Bharati Vidyapeeth Deemed to be University, Dental College and Hospital, Sangli by organizing Camps where Lecture was delivered by Dr. Anirudh Shete, NSS Assistant Programme Officer on Oral Hygiene, Nutritional awareness, importance of physical activities to keep fit, discussion on skipping breakfast, untimely eating, impact of fast food and packaged food items on teeth and its prevention was also discussed.

<u>CAMP-1</u> - On 20/09/2022 a dental screening camp was arranged by at Kasturbai Walchand College Sangli. A team consisting of 6 students were assigned to deliver the services through an outreach program along with one faculty. The screening of Patients started at 10:30 AM and continued until 12:45 P.M. Total 96 subjects were screened. They mostly suffered from dental caries, and periodontal diseases.

Tooth brushing technique was explained with the help of brushing model.

Subjects requiring the treatment were referred to BVDU Dental College and hospital for needful treatment at concessional cost. Referral cards were given to the patients for the discount in the treatment procedures along with free toothpastes.



<u>CAMP-2</u> - On 27/09/2022 a dental screening camp was arranged at Zilla Parishad Shala No 1 (boys) and Zilla Parishad Shala No 2 (girls), Arag. A team consisting of 7 students was assigned to deliver the services through an outreach program along with one faculty. The screening of Patients started at 10:45 AM and continued until 3:30 P.M. Total 796 subjects were screened. They mostly suffered from dental caries and malocclusion. Tooth brushing technique was explained with the help of brushing model. Subjects requiring the treatment were referred to BVDU Dental College and hospital for needful treatment at concessional cost. Referral cards were given to the patients for the discount in the treatment procedures along with free toothpastes.
